Thursday, August 27 – Student Organization Information Sessions

12:30 or 4:30, Library Auditorium

For advisors and students – this is an opportunity to find out how you can gain additional funding for your student organization, as well as learning about the resources available to you from the Student Life office, such as the poster or button maker, as well as other marketing opportunities. It is highly encouraged that you send at least one student and advisor from your organization, as you will be signing up for a table for the Activities Fair at this session. It is not necessary to attend both sessions as they will be the same; they are offered twice to accommodate schedules.

A representative from each student organization is asked to attend and to be prepared to give a brief presentation on what your organization is about and how students can obtain more information.
